## **OAKLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT CCW QUALIFICATION**

### **OBJECTIVES:**

This firearm live fire qualification course is a basic, timed static line paper silhouette FAQ course which emphasizes and test the shooter's ability to perform the following:

Drawing quickly and smoothly from the holster  
Use of holster(s) commonly utilized for concealed carry Intermediate  
to close quarters shooting skills  
Accuracy and stress shooting drills with multiple shots

### **COURSE:**

Static silhouette shooting using a B-27 target. All strings should be from the holster and center mass, unless otherwise noted. **(18 rounds total, minimum passing score 126 out of 180 or 70%)**

**5 yard line:** Draw and fire 6 rounds center mass in 10 seconds **7**

**yard line:** Draw and fire 6 rounds center mass in 15 seconds **10**

**yard line:** Draw and fire 6 rounds center mass in 20 seconds

6 rounds are fired at each distance unless the weapon only holds 5 rounds. **(15 rounds total, minimum passing score is 105 out of 150 or 70%)**

18 rounds total, minimum passing score: 126 points out of 180 points possible, or 70%.

\*If the weapon only holds 5 rounds (ex: a revolver with a cylinder that only holds 5 rounds, NOT a ten round magazine downloaded to 5 rounds) each station shall have a round count of 5 rounds, and maintain the same time limit. In that case, minimum passing score is 105 points out of 150 point possible, or 70%.

### **SCORES:**

Scores are calculated by adding the total point value of all impacts on target. Each scoring zone point value is reflected by the printed number on the target (7, 8, 9, X, with X having a point value of 10. Impacts which land on a line between different scoring zones will be scored with the point value of the lower scoring zone (ex: an impact on the line between scoring zone 7 and 8 will be given the point value 7). Impacts outside the 7-ring, inclusive of the head, have a point value of zero. Shots fired after the end of the time limit shall not be counted.

### **ATTEMPTS:**

Students shall have three attempts per firearm to qualify. If the student fails to qualify for whatever reason (all shots taken, or not all shots taken due to weapons manipulation ex: operating the safety or holster, or not all shots taken due to weapon malfunction/failure, which result in a score under 70%) after the three attempts, then the proof of qualification shall indicate "failed" for that firearm. The student may attempt to qualify with their other listed firearms. A student desiring to qualify with a firearm with which they failed to qualify previously, must wait seven days before making another attempt to qualify.

### **SAFETY GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION:**

If, in the instructor's opinion, the student demonstrates gross unsafe handling of a firearm, inclusive, but not limited to, poor muzzle discipline or pointing the firearm at self/others during presentation, holstering, reloading, or other manipulations, impacts completely off target, drops weapon, horseplay, or other criteria that makes the trainer believe the student is not currently capable of safely using their firearm, the instructor will document the observations and the proof of qualification shall indicate "failed" for all listed firearms. These two items will then be forwarded to the department for review.
