

## INTERVIEW AND APPLICANT FINGERPRINTING

Pursuant to **Penal Code section 26185** and **California Code of Regulations, title 11, section 4420**, all applicants, **including non-resident applicants**, are required to submit fingerprints electronically via Live Scan in **California** to initiate the background check process.

**Non-residents are recommended to schedule their CCW interview appointment for a date when they will be physically present in California.**

- The **Live Scan fingerprinting process will be conducted by the San Luis Obispo County Sheriff's Office at the time of your scheduled interview appointment.**
- Applicants are **not required to complete a Live Scan prior to the interview.**
- Fingerprints will be captured and transmitted electronically by an authorized Live Scan operator in compliance with state regulations.

## IMPORTANT NOTES

- Do **not** complete a BCIA 8016 Live Scan form independently unless specifically instructed by this office.
- Fingerprint cards (FD-258) **will not be accepted.**
- Failure to appear for your scheduled interview may delay processing of your application.

### **\*DISCLAIMER\***

The live scan fees **are** included in the initial payment that is charged at the time of application submission. If an applicant completes their live scan at an agency **other than the San Luis Obispo County Sheriff's Office**, the applicant will be responsible for the live scan fees charged by the other agency and **will not** be refunded.
